

Washington Nationals Expand Coverage Across Mid-Atlantic with WTTG FOX 5 and Gray Media Partnerships

FOX 5 will also serve as the Nationals' **Weather Day partner**, welcoming local school children for an afternoon of interactive education and baseball — this year held on **Thursday, May 7**. FOX 5 will also provide radar and meteorological updates during weather delays, keeping fans informed on the status of inclement weather.

stations will begin at the same time as Nationals.TV broadcasts.
